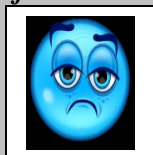
In the Bunker:

Did you know!

Golf club grips are almost always ignored by most amateurs according to David Leadbetter, international coach to some of the world's best golfers. Your golf grips should be washed down in mild soapy water usually once a month to get rid of any dirt, grease etc from the profiles on the grips. They should be examined for splits and generally it is recommended that they are replaced every two to three years.

David also recommends that every golfer should have the correct grips fitted. Too small a grip will cause you to grip the club too hard and too large a grip will allow the head to turn on impact.

His web site offers this quick tip, take a club and stand as if you are going to hit a shot, now raise the club vertically still holding with the same grip. Remove your right hand. Now look at the position of your middle, ring and pinky fingers. They should just be touching the palm of your hand. If there is a space between your fingers and the palm chances are your grips are too big. Likewise if your nails are digging into your palm the grips are usually too small. Opposite applies to left handers and anyone who is bifocal!!!!!!
